Drain Line Flushing: Night Work

130th Ave Roundabout at Tsuu T'ina Trail Northbound off Ramp

WHAT: KGL is flushing drainage lines along the Southwest Calgary Ring Road. Flushing requires buffer trucks to support hydrovac trucks in parking along the sides of road to clean underground storm lines. Night work is being undertaken to minimize the traffic impact during the day.

WHERE: 130th Ave Roundabout at Tsuu T'ina Trail Northbound off Ramp

WHEN: Approximately the week of March 1st, 2021. Work cannot be performed at temperatures below -20° C and is therefore weather dependent.

WORK HOURS: Between 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS: Residents may notice construction noise and construction equipment traffic. Shoulder/lane closures along the above roads allowing for the delivery of work vehicles and hydrovac trucks. Residents may notice noise from hydrovac trucks as they are parked in the shoulder/lane closures cleaning underground storm lines.
